Introduction

Introduction

The Garmin CCD2 digital devices come pre-loaded with the necessary apps.

At installation, you will be required to:

- Connect to in-store Wi-Fi
- Check Bluetooth is on
- Login to Trainer App and connect the trainer hardware
 - Use the account you have created at **Garmin.com** and the app code shared with you by the Garmin Sales Rep.
- Connect the device to the online content management platform
- Scan the QR code to log the player and store location information

Introduction



There is wireless keyboard/trackpad available should the touchscreen not work.




If the **USB adapter** is not already connected to the media player, remove it from the housing and place it in a free USB port in the media player.




The **On/Off** switch is located on the side, along with a **USB-C** port if you need to charge it.


Once the device is booted, you will see these 2 apps on the **Home Screen**.



Swipe up from the bottom to open the app drawer and tap **Settings**.




Tap **Network and Internet**



Now tap **Internet**



Tap the **in-store SSID** (you may have to talk to store staff to get this) and input the password. It should say connected under the name when it has connected to the network.
Tap the **Back** button **twice** to go back to the **Settings** menu.




To check Bluetooth is turned on, tap **Connected Devices**



Now tap **Connection Preferences**




Then tap **Bluetooth**




Check the **Bluetooth** radio dial is turned **ON**.
Press the **Home** button to return to the Home Screen.




Tap the **Tacx Trainer app** icon to configure the experience.



Tap **Continue with Garmin**



Tap to place a **tick** next to, 'I have read and agree to the EULA.' Click **Next**.



Tap **Sign In**.
On the next screen input the **Username** and **password** that has been shared with you.




Next connect your trainer hardware.
In this case a **Neo T2**.




You will see LED's illuminate on the side.


Configure the Trainer App




You should now be at the **Dashboard** in the Trainer app. Tap **Connect Trainer** in the top right.




You should see the trainer device you just powered up in the list of available devices.




Tap it, and you should see it go **green**, which means its connected successfully. Tap the **Back** button at the top to go back to the **Dashboard**.



The Trainer app setup is now complete. Press the **Home** button to go back to the home screen.



Tap **OnSignTV** icon to start configuring the content management platform.




Tap **Sign In**. On the next screen input the **Username** and **password** that has been shared with you.

From the Home Screen, tap the **OnSignTV** icon to load the CMS.




This time you will be presented with a 6-digit code that you need to input into onsign.tv to connect the screen to our CMS.





On a mobile device scan the QR code or go to <https://app.onsign.tv/login/> and login






Once you login, tap the 3 lines in the top right and the tap **Players**.

Connecting to the CMS


*****NB: The naming convention is very important to the location of the device and analytics collected. Please make sure you name the players you add as per below.*****



In the windows the appears, enter the 6-digit code you see on the screen you are trying to add.




Enter the 6-digit pin that appeared on the device.




- Now we need to enter a name for the player and add it to the player group to download the content.
- The naming convention to be used to name the player is:
Player number - Retailer – Town, postcode
For example: **Player 21 – Curry’s – Baldock SG7 0DE**
- Select the player group from the drop down.
- Next click **Add Player**

Connecting to the CMS



In the Players window you should now see the player connected via Wi-Fi, and content being downloaded to the player.




If you check the screen, you should also see a loading bar with a percentage completion bar. Once it has completed downloading it will automatically load the content.


Configuration of the CCD unit is now complete!

and the Trainer app


To go back and forth between the content and the trainer app:




Tap 5 times in the bottom left corner of the content and enter the password: **tacxg**



Tap the **TacX Trainer** icon on the home screen.



To leave the Trainer app once finished and return to the content, tap the **Home** button



Tap the **OnSign TV** icon on the Home Screen to restart the content.
