Connecting the Hardware

- Connect the power lead to the socket on the back of the screen.
- Connect the HDMI cable to the HDMI port closest to the power lead on the back of the screen.
- Press the switch to turn the screen on.

USB Display HDMI HDMI OSB Port Switch

• Connect the power supply, Wi-Fi antenna, and other end of the HDMI cable to the media player inputs.





Connecting the Hardware

On the front of the media player, connect your USB mouse to • one of the USB ports. **Do not** use the OTG port. The mouse will not work

• Now look at the screen and right click with your mouse.

• You will see a dialogue box asking if you wan to shutdown the content. Tap OK to exit.











Connecting to a Wi-Fi network



From the Home Screen tap the **white circle with the 6 dots** to open the **app drawer.**

Tap the Wi-FI icon.
